

EMERGENCY ALERT MAST CELL DISEASE

I have a mast cell disease. During a reaction, mast cells release mediators can make me ill and CAN BE LIFE THREATENING. See symptoms on back!

If semi-conscious/near fainting: Lay me down. Call 911. Ask for Paramedics. Say I may be experiencing **anaphylaxis**. Look for my EpiPen/epinephrine autoinjector and have it ready for the paramedics. **Emergency Protocols on www.tmsforcure.org/er.**

If conscious: I may be able to manage my symptoms. Do not leave me alone. I need immediate access to my medications, bottled water, restroom and exit.
